Although we have published our compliance with the UK government guidelines statement, Rotork uses a consistent comprehensive risk assessment process for all sites globally.

The risk assessments carried out by the Rotork's Health and Safety team at all our sites include additional measures that we have introduced under the following sections:

- Who should return to work?
- Protecting those who are at higher risk
- Getting into and leaving work; including travel support, temperature and health checks, staggered start and finish times and a one way system
- Work areas; including shift working and one way systems
- Air movements
- Common areas; such as canteens, toilets and showers
- Good hygiene
- What to do if there is a confirmed case
- Social factors; including training, communication and wellbeing

These robust measures will ensure that our colleagues stay as safe as possible at all times.
